

Dean's Office 2021 Summer Project Assistantship

For 2021, the Maxwell Dean's Office will fund up to ten summer project assistantship (SPA) awards in the amount of \$2,000 each. SPA awards fund summer research assistance for the purpose of developing a research proposal. Successful faculty applicants will receive funding for the graduate assistant (GA) of their choice, must provide a progress report describing GA work accomplished, and should subsequently submit a related proposal to an external funder.

Key Dates

April 21, 2021	SPA application deadline
April 23, 2021	Funding notifications
May 28, 2021	GA selection due
August 27, 2021	Progress report due
June 1, 2022	Deadline to submit external proposal

Guidelines

1. Funding decisions primarily will be based on the merit of the proposal submitted, with preference given to applications from faculty members who have not received SPA awards in the past. All applications will be considered based on the likelihood of a SPA award resulting in the submission of a competitive external proposal.
2. Proposals may list multiple faculty applicants but can only be used to support one GA. You may submit a proposal before selecting a GA; however, student names and SU ID numbers must be provided to Holly Johnson (hjohns02@syr.edu) in the Dean's Office by Friday, May 28, 2021. You must confirm that the student has not been awarded another SPA from a different Maxwell unit before promising an award. The GA is expected to complete approximately 80 hours of work on the project over the course of the summer.
3. Resulting external proposals are expected to include funding for one or more graduate students.
4. Faculty who are awarded a summer project assistantship must submit (1) a written progress report by August 27, 2021, and (2) a related proposal to an external funder by June 1, 2022. Failure to meet these expectations will exclude recipients from subsequent summer project assistantship funding cycles.
