 - You need a minimum of 6 upper division (numbered 300+) courses for your concentration
- Concentration courses that aren't also meeting a distribution requirement do NOT need to, but can, come from this list; see concentration checklist guidelines.
- See **course prerequisites** on MySlice (part of the course detail). Selected Topics sections (ending in "00") may have prereqs listed under "notes" or not listed.
- Be prepared with some choices and alternatives. Your first choices may be closed!
