

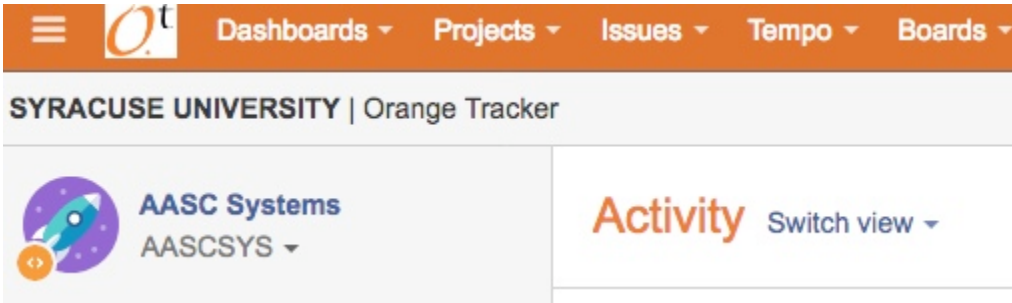
View the Activity or Statistics of the project

Orange Tracker has views to display the current activity and statistics for each project. The Activity screen will show the user what issues are actively being worked, like who is creating new issues, adding comments, and closing issue tickets. The Statistics screen displays many common filters to organize your issues tickets and helps the user understand key elements.

To view these screens, first select the project from the Projects pull-down. Once you are in the project, click on the Project Name near the top:



After the page loads, you should see the Activity screen. To see the Statistics screen, use the Switch View button to the right of the Activity title:



This will bring you to the Statistics screen:
