Hold four-year degree from an American university; 3.7 GPA

Pickering Fellowship

Applicants must be entering a 2-year Master's program; US Citizens; 3.2 GPA

Rangel Fellowship

Seeking admission in relevant, two-year graduate program; seniors or recent graduates; US citizen; 3.2 cumulative GPA
